A NOTE OF EXPLANATION ABOUT TERMINOLOGY:

Although everyone uses the terms “elements of art” and “principles of art”, there is no universal agreement about what are the elements and principles. In this set of outcomes **elements** refers to concepts like point, line, shape, value, color, texture, form, and space; **principles** refers to concepts like balance, variety (contrast), repetition (rhythm), emphasis, movement, and unity (harmony).
