FIRST GRADE

- 1. Demonstrates all Kindergarten Outcomes and builds upon that foundation.**
- 2. Imitates language sounds.**
 - A. Pronounces vocabulary with reasonable accuracy by imitating teacher.
 - B. Knows several songs which reinforce pronunciation.
 - C. Can discriminate vowel sounds in Spanish.
- 3. Communicates on a limited number of topics (weather, months and days, clothing, school, etc.).**
 - A. Responds to basic questions.
 - B. Identifies and names targeted vocabulary.
 - C. Responds appropriately through action to various verbal commands in Spanish.
- 4. Uses and understands numbers 1 – 50 verbally.**
 - A. Identifies numbers randomly and sequentially.
 - B. Uses numbers to count, express age, express date, telephone number, and to play simple games.
- 5. Listens and comprehends simple stories and conversations in Spanish.**
 - A. Uses observational skills and active listening skills to derive meaning.
 - B. Answers simple questions.
