KINDERGARTEN

- 1. Uses basic social expressions.**
 - A. Knows words for conventional greetings and farewells and uses them appropriately.

- 2. Imitates language sounds.**
 - A. Pronounce vocabulary with reasonable accuracy using teacher as model.
 - B. Knows several songs and poems which reinforce correct pronunciation.

- 3. Responds to basic questions (names, age, feelings, physical states).**
 - A. Identifies and names targeted vocabulary (classroom objects, colors, body, animals, family members).
 - B. Responds appropriately through action to various verbal commands in the classroom.

- 4. Uses and understands numbers 1 – 30 in Spanish.**
 - A. Identifies numbers randomly and sequentially.
 - B. Uses numbers to count objects and express age.

- 5. Listens and comprehends simple stories and conversations in Spanish.**
