

Junior Great Books

Junior Great Books is a national reading enrichment program offered to all OLG students Kindergarten through 4th grade. The curriculum develops higher-level thinking, vocabulary and comprehension skills through reading outstanding works of literature. Junior Great Books is a program for all ability levels. Parent volunteers lead small discussion groups while students read and explore stories, fables, fairy tales and myths.

The program is offered in the fall for a six week period (Kindergarten lasts only four weeks). The students meet with their parent volunteers once a week during the lunch/recess period. The 2008-2009 fee for Junior Great books is \$15 per student. Student registration forms are distributed by the classroom teachers in September. Parent Volunteers may sign up during registration.
