The 7th and 8th Grade Math Team is comprised of two parts: the Minnesota Junior High Math League and MathCounts.

The purpose of the Junior High Math League is to encourage students to participate in math contests, enable students to meet mathletes from other schools, and to provide recognition for students excelling in mathematics. It also serves as preparation for the annual MathCounts competition. The meet topics are based on the MathCounts topics. The students compete five times throughout the year at various schools in the SW Metro area.

The mission of MathCounts is to increase enthusiasm for and enhance achievement in middle school mathematics throughout the United States. The MathCounts Competition Program provides the extra incentive and the perfect atmosphere for students to push themselves to achieve more in mathematics. Consisting of fun and creative problems, the MATHCOUNTS competitions have written and oral rounds, as well as individual and team components. One competition is held in February for a group of students to compete.
