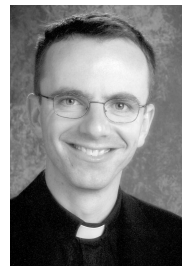
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 14TH: FATHER CHRISTOPHER BEAUDET
