



We are a two-time **Blue Ribbon School of Excellence Award Winner** 

Our Middle School students completed over **3,000 service hours** in 2017-2018.

The 2018 8th Grade Students tested in the **top 1% of the nation** in both **Reading and Math**.

Over **200 students celebrate first sacraments** annually: Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

While 58% of our students are from Edina, our **students come from 27 cities** for their OLG education.

There are **25 students** in each **Kindergarten classroom**.

We have **10 Teacher Assistants** serving in our K-8 Classrooms

We have **3 classrooms** per grade level and a **One-To-One Technology Program** so that every student has a computer or tablet.

Our **Parent School Organization has 40 committees** in the areas of Classroom Support, Service, Fellowship, Fundraising and School Support.
