

Middle School Service Hours

- BASIC INFORMATION -

All students are required to complete 3 service hours per quarter and fill out the service hours reflection form *at least* one week prior to the end of the quarter.

Basic rule of thumb: Service hours should take place *outside* of the home.

Other guidelines:

- Service hours should not come from something which is a typical family expectation (mowing the lawn, doing the dishes, watching little brothers/sisters, etc.)
- A student cannot use service hours if they were paid for it (example: paying someone for babysitting). Students may encourage his or her “supervisor” to donate it to a different cause.
- Service hours from the summer may be used for the 1st quarter. All other service hours must occur during each particular quarter. Students may not “pile up” service hours to use throughout the year.
- Altar serving, Sharing and Caring, Vacation Bible School, and Service Club projects may all be used for service hours.
