

Foley Packing List

Warm sleeping bag and/or extra blankets
1 sheet to cover mattress
Pillow
2 towels and toiletries (no aerosol cans)
Warm pajamas or sweats
3 pair of pants, 1 pair of shorts
4 shirts
Raincoat or rain suit (classes continue in the rain)
2 sweatshirts (or fleece)
Sweatpants
2 pairs of old shoes that can get wet and muddy
6 pairs of socks
Winter jacket, hat, mittens, or gloves
Hat for sun protection
4 pencils or pens
Plastic bag for wet items
Daypack or book bag
Water bottle

OPTIONAL: Bathing suit, camera, flashlight, Chapstick, bug/tick repellent, sunscreen, rubber boots

HINTS: Spring temperatures can vary from 35° at night to 80° during the day.

It can rain or snow or be pleasantly warm. Extra blankets are recommended if using light sleeping bags. Old clothes and shoes are preferred. Light colored pants are best for detecting wood ticks. Sweatpants are convenient for activities around water. Students will need a bag or pack to carry pencils, workbook, raincoat or extra sweatshirt throughout the day.

It is requested that students **DO NOT** bring gum, candy, radios, tape players, electronic games, blow dryers, and curling irons. These items are not appropriate for the learning that is taking place at the Center and will be collected from the students upon arrival.

NO FOOD OF ANY KIND OR POP/SPORTS DRINKS, ETC. WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE BUS. BOTTLED WATER WILL BE ALLOWED.

ELECTRONICS: CD players, Gameboys, etc., **WILL BE** allowed on the bus. These items will be collected upon arrival at Camp Foley and returned prior to departure. If students are caught using these items during the camp session, the item will be confiscated and returned at the end of the school years (June 8th).
